RULES & REGULATIONS:

Exhibitors must read and observe the General Information and Health Requirements at www.montanafair.com or in the front of this Exhibitor's Handbook. In addition, the following rules apply:

1. All wool must be Montana or Wyoming grown.
2. Entries are limited to two (2) entries from any one (1) exhibitor in any class.
3. Entries must be made in the name of the grower.
4. Wool shorn in 2008 or 2009 is eligible.
5. Shorn wool (no more than 12 months growth).
7. Preparation - fleeces should be tied with paper twine, flesh side out and then placed in a plastic garbage bag.
8. Any plastic twine will disqualify a fleece.
