A fee of \$20 will be assessed on any item not picked up on August 17, 2009 if special arrangements have been made with the Superintendent before that date.

**PREMIUMS:** NEW IN 2009! Premiums will be awarded in all classes. Judge is not required to award premiums or awards for 1st, 2nd or 3rd in all classes if judge does not find exhibit worthy of award.

**CLUB AWARDS:** Yellowstone County Extension Family & Community Education Clubs: MontanaFair will give a total of \$150 in cash to the top three clubs winning the greatest number of points in Horticulture, Art Needlework and Culinary (1st-\$75, 2nd-\$50, 3rd-\$25). Members enter in their own name and must indicate the name of their Yellowstone County Extension Family and Community Education Club on the entry form. Entries will not be counted if club is not included on entry form. The individual entering is eligible for the individual places. Points will be awarded to the Club that this member belongs to and has placed under and will accumulate as follows: 1st - 4 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points and Honorable Mention - 1 point. Individuals will earn 1 point for their Club for each scheduled demonstration done during MontanaFair. Percentage of Club Member participation will be calculated and 30 points will be awarded to the highest percentage, 20 points will be awarded to the second highest percentage, and 10 points will be awarded to the third highest percentage. **MEMORIAL AWARD:** In 1998, MontanaFair established an annual high point award in memory of Karen Erfle-Holman, past Superintendent of Heritage Arts. This award will be bestowed upon the outstanding exhibitor in Heritage Arts (winner to be selected by the greatest number of blue ribbons earned on individual entries in Departments J, K and L). Exhibitor must compete in all three Heritage Arts Departments to be eligible for this award. MontanaFair will award this exhibitor with \$50. The winning exhibitor's name will be engraved on a permanent memorial plaque displayed in Heritage Arts in the Montana Pavilion Building. Points will be accumulated by the Entry Office. Please do not pre-enter class. Department JKL, Division 2, Class 101.

2. Every article entered must entirely be the work of the exhibitor.
3. All articles must be ENTIRELY FINISHED.
4. Articles competing for prizes must have been finished within the last three years.
5. All imported articles are strictly prohibited from competition, but may be placed on exhibition. Hand needlework firms are not permitted to compete for prizes.
6. Heritage items can be entered for "DISPLAY ONLY". These items will also be required to remain in place until the close of MontanaFair, (see Exhibits Released).
7. Mark front side and top of Quilts and Afghans so they are displayed to your satisfaction.
8. In order to safeguard against loss in this department, no one will be permitted to handle any article when once put in

- place, with the exception of the Judge or Superintendent's staff.
9. No article in this department, when once in place, can be moved to another division nor will it be judged in any class other than the class in which it is entered.
  10. Articles will be awarded, first, second, third or no ribbon, according to the merits of the article. No ribbon will be awarded when the article is unworthy, even though there is no competition.
  11. Any soiled, stained or excessively worn item will be disqualified at the Superintendent's discretion.

**JUDGING WILL BE BASED ON:**

- 1) All needlework will be judged with regard to beauty, degree of perfection, amount of work, and suitability for the purpose for which it is intended.
- 2) The following score card for Judging Art Needlework exhibits has been adopted as recommended by the Bureau of Home Economics, Washington, DC.

7. All stamped articles: Use of a single tool for multiple impressions on article. Swivel knife cuts for borders only. (Example of tools used for this would be basket weave, geometric, border or combination thereof).
8. All Carved articles: The design is cut with a swivel knife and various other stamping tools are used to shade and accent. (Stamping tools would include the beveler, pear shader, veiner, flower center, etc.)
9. Not carved or stamped: Any type of leather. Articles may be decorated by any combination of color, stitching, burning, beadwork, hardware, etc.
10. Book covers and notebooks must contain book or paper pad. Ring binders must contain at least one sample page.
11. Belts must include attached buckle, and keeper if necessary. Holes must be punched appropriately if a mechanical or trophy buckle is used.
12. Jewelry boxes, cigar boxes, humidors, picture frames: If piece is made to hold something specific (i.e. paper towels, cigars, etc.), please include it so that the piece will be functionally complete. NOTE: Frames cannot contain a leather picture.
13. Zippered articles are considered to be cases. Enter under appropriate size.
