### FEES:

Exhibitor Fee: \$5 per Exhibitor

Entry Fee: \$1.50 per class

(Rabbits not entered in Open Rabbit Show(s) or 4-H Rabbit Division will not be allowed on grounds).

**PRE-ENTRY IS REQUIRED.** Online entry at www.montanafair.com is encouraged for eligibility in MontanaFair online entry contests. If not entered online, entry forms must be postmarked by August 1, 2009. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT SHOW. No entry will be considered complete unless accompanied by appropriate fees. Please do not email entries to the Superintendents, they will not be accepted. Fax entries must include credit card payment information (or note call for "Credit Card Information" on entry form) or exhibitor may call MontanaFair Entry Office (406) 256-2400 prior to August 1, 2009 deadline with credit card information. Entries submitted without payment in full are considered incomplete and will not be processed.

**CHECK IN: New in 2009!** - Expo Center

Saturday, August 8, 2009 - 12:00 noon to 7:00 p.m.

Sunday, August 9, 2009 - 7:00 a.m.

All rabbits must be in the building by 7:00 a.m. Sunday, August 9th.

**No parking** is allowed at Expo Center. Enter at Gate #1 (Livestock Entrance) and obtain unloading permit for rabbit division. Vehicles must park in designated public parking lots. Violators will be towed at owner's expense. See map for Gate 1 location.

**GATE ADMISSION:** A season pass may be purchased for \$18 or exhibitors may purchase a one-day admission ticket for \$4 (1/2 off regular admission price). MontanaFair will provide one day gate pass to exhibitors who enter five or more entries in any one department. Maximum one per exhibitor.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. ARBA Rules: MontanaFair is offering official ARBA sanctioned shows. American Rabbit Breeder Association Chartered and Sanctioned Shows are governed by the latest official show rules of the Association. Exhibitors who wish to register their stock under this system will have the opportunity to do so during these shows with an ARBA Registrar (to be announced). All rabbits will be judged according to the ARBA Standard of Perfection. Sanctions at the shows will be recognized as required by sanction rules (American Rabbit Breeders Association, ARBA, Brad Boyce, Executive Director, PO Box 5667, Bloomington, IL 61702).
2. All entries must be made on the printed form. If you need more than one form, you may duplicate the entry form. Entry form must include breed and variety, ear #, sex and class, and all exhibitor information. Entry forms not accompanied by fees will not be accepted.
3. Substitutions: No substitutions will be made except for same class, breed and sex. All changes must be given to the show secretary by 7:30 a.m. Sunday, August 9th - NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. Tattoo: All rabbits exhibited must bear registration of pedigree, tattoo numbers properly placed in ear, and listed on entry blank and shipping crates. There will be a fee of \$1 charged for tattooing rabbits and a \$.50 charge for each change made on entry blank. No ear number on an entry blank will constitute a change. All allowable changes must be made before the start of judging.
5. Show Responsibility: All exhibitors will be responsible for handling their own animals to and from the show table, unless prior arrangements are made with the Superintendent.
6. Cooping: This a carry-cage show. Cages must be self-contained.
7. Sick Rabbits: Any animal showing symptoms of disease shall be removed from the show area at once. Any associated costs will be the responsibility of the owner and entry fees will be forfeited.
8. Awards: Awards will be awarded at the show. There will be no mailing of ribbons or awards.
9. Sanctioned Breeds: The list of sanctioned breeds will be available at the show or by calling the Superintendent before the show. If you wish to sanction a breed you may call the Superintendent. ARBA sanction #'s to be mailed and paid for by the exhibitor.
10. Breeding: No breeding will be allowed in the showroom without consent of both owners and knowledge of show superintendent.
11. Judging: Judge's decisions are final. Anyone interfering with, attempting to influence or deceive the judge will be disqualified and any awards won forfeited along with entry fees.
12. One youth class will be offered. All rabbit(s) shown by junior exhibitors must be owned and cared for by the junior exhibitor. No other junior exhibitor classes are offered. Junior exhibitors are welcome in open competition.
13. Changes: Any changes in scheduled judging times will be posted at the desk in the display building.
14. Only animals that have an ARBA classification of intermediate and pre-junior may enter the intermediate and pre-junior classes.
15. If entering exhibition class, exhibitor must bring current working standards.
