RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Exhibitors please read and observe the General Information at the front of this Exhibitor's Handbook. Proper entry and identification is essential.
2. Open to all Montana and Wyoming residents.
3. No individual shall enter more than one (1) entry in any lot.
4. Mark entry forms if entries are to be returned.

DIVISION 1 - Sheaf Grains

All sheaf exhibits must have a circumference at the base of the head of a minimum of 5 ½", tied with colored ribbon or cloth in three (3) places. Leaves should be removed. Sheaf exhibits will be judged on the following basis:

- 50% Artistic Arrangement**
- 25% Head Size**
- 25% Seed Quality**

DIVISION 4 - Sugar Beets

Six beets will constitute an exhibit. All beets should be topped so that no green is showing. Feeder roots that are ½" in diameter and less should be cut off. The beets should be uniform and free from dirt, well topped, flat, no stems and ½" of leaf scar.

DIVISION 5 - Baled Hay

Hay shall be dry and cured with 5-8# sample. Exhibit shall be contained in a durable plastic garbage bag.

DIVISION 6 - Sheaf Forage

All forage, except corn silage, must be cured and dry. Sheaf shall have a minimum of 5 1/2" circumference and be tied in three places.

- T-6-44 Sorghum (3 stalks, FRESH, with roots)
- T-6-45 Silage Corn (3 stalks, FRESH, with roots)
- T-6-46 Alfalfa
- T-6-47 Red Clover
- T-6-48 Grass
- T-6-49 Cereal Grain Hay (wheat, oats, barley)
- T-6-50 Other Dried Forages

DIVISION 7 - Silage - Chopped

Five pounds of silage shall be contained in a double plastic "zip-lock" type bag or CLEAR plastic bag with a tie top.
