ENTRY DEADLINE: Online pre-Entry is strongly recommended to be eligible for online entry contests, but online or pre-entry hard copy entries are not required. Pre-entries are due by Friday, July 29, 2011 by 5:00 pm. Pre-entry will ensure a speedy check-in of your articles. No online entry after July 29th @ 5:00, but you may enter by hard copy until exhibits are received at the time stated below. EXHIBITS RECEIVED: Montana Pavilion - Friday, August 5, 2011, 10:00 am – 6:00 pm and Saturday, August 6, 2011 from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm. **NO EXHIBITS ACCEPTED AFTER SATURDAY, AUGUST 6th, 3:00 PM.** Please come early and allow yourself time to be checked in and verify that all requirements for entering are met.

JUDGING: Sunday, August 7, 2011, 10:00 am – 6:00 pm

EXHIBIT HOURS: August 13–19, 2011, 12:00 - 9:00 pm & Saturday, August 20st 12:00 - 6:00 pm.

GATE ADMISSION: MontanaFair will provide one fee day gate admission pass to exhibitors who enter five or more entries in any one department. Exhibitors may purchase a MontanaFair season pass for \$20.00 or a one day gate pass for \$5.00 at time of entry.

EXHIBITS RELEASED: Sunday, August 21, 2011 – 11:00 am – 3:00 pm. **A fee of \$20.00 will be assessed on any item not picked up on Sunday, August 21, 2011 unless special arrangements have been made with the Superintendent before that date.** After that date, MontanaFair will not be responsible for exhibits, no security is provided and exhibits may be discarded.

PREMIUMS: Premiums awarded in all classes to three places: 1st \$4.00 – 2nd \$3.00 – 3rd - \$2.00 (Except where noted in division). Ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Best of Show rosettes to best overall winners selected from Needlework & Craft classes.

SPECIAL AWARDS: All sponsored special premiums will be awarded at the discretion of the Heritage Arts Director.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1) Exhibitors must read and observe the MontanaFair General Information at www.montanafair.com (separate section on MontanaFair website). In addition, the following rules apply to Department K:
- 2) Every article entered must entirely be the work of the exhibitor.
- 3) All articles must be ENTIRELY FINISHED.
- 4) Articles competing for prizes must have been finished within the last three years.
- 5) All imported articles are strictly prohibited from competition, but may be placed on exhibition. Hand needlework firms are not permitted to compete for prizes.
- 6) Heritage items can be entered for "DISPLAY ONLY". These items will also be required to remain in place until the close of MontanaFair, (see Exhibits Released).
- 7) Mark front side and top of Quilts and Afghans so they are displayed to your satisfaction.
- 8) In order to safeguard against loss in this department, no one will be permitted to handle any article when once put in place, with the exception of the Judge or Superintendent's staff.
- 9) No article in this department, when once in place, can be moved to another division nor will it be judged in any class other than the class in which it is entered.

10) Articles will be awarded, first, second, third or no ribbon, according to the merits of the article. No ribbon will be awarded when the article is unworthy, even though there is no competition.

11) Any soiled, stained or excessively worn item will be disqualified at the Superintendent's discretion.

JUDGING WILL BE BASED ON:

1) All needlework will be judged with regard to beauty, degree of perfection, amount of work, and suitability for the purpose for which it is intended.

2) The following score card for Judging Art Needlework exhibits has been adopted as recommended by the Bureau of Home Economics, Washington, DC.

Beginner level would include exhibitors that have not been judged in competitive exhibitions; Intermediate level would include exhibitors that have entered in competitive exhibitions and been judged; Experienced Level would include those who derive income from the sale of exhibits or who have won over 10 blue ribbons in the exhibit division.

All stamped articles: Use of a single tool for multiple impressions on article. Swivel knife cuts for borders only. (Example of tools used for this would be basket weave, geometric, border or combination thereof).

All Carved articles: The design is cut with a swivel knife and various other stamping tools are used to shade and accent. (Stamping tools would include the beveller, pear shaver, veiner, flower center, etc.)

Not carved or stamped: Any type of leather. Articles may be decorated by any combination of color, stitching, burning, beadwork, hardware, etc.

Book covers and notebooks must contain book or paper pad. Ring binders must contain at least one sample page.

Belts must include attached buckle, and keeper if necessary. Holes must be punched appropriately if a mechanical or trophy buckle is used.

Jewelry boxes, cigar boxes, humidors, picture frames: If piece is made to hold something specific (i.e. paper towels, cigars, etc.), please include it so that the piece will be functionally complete. NOTE: Frames cannot contain a leather picture.

Zippered articles are considered to be cases. Enter under appropriate size.

Masters/Professionals -Those who derive significant income from leather craft or whose work is of a high skill level. No kits will be allowed.
